## **Am I eligible?**

- N Must be a Canadian citizen, a person who has been granted refugee status in Canada or are legally entitled to work in Canada.
- N Between the ages of 15 – 30 years old at the start of internship.
- N A full-time high school or post-secondary student and intending to return to school in the fall.

- N Not in receipt of Employment Insurance (EI) during the internship.
  - N From and/or will be residing in Nova Scotia for the duration of the internship.
