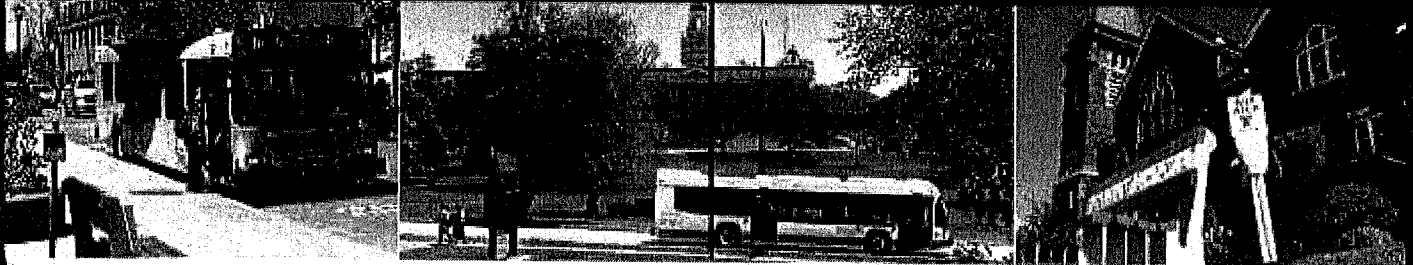
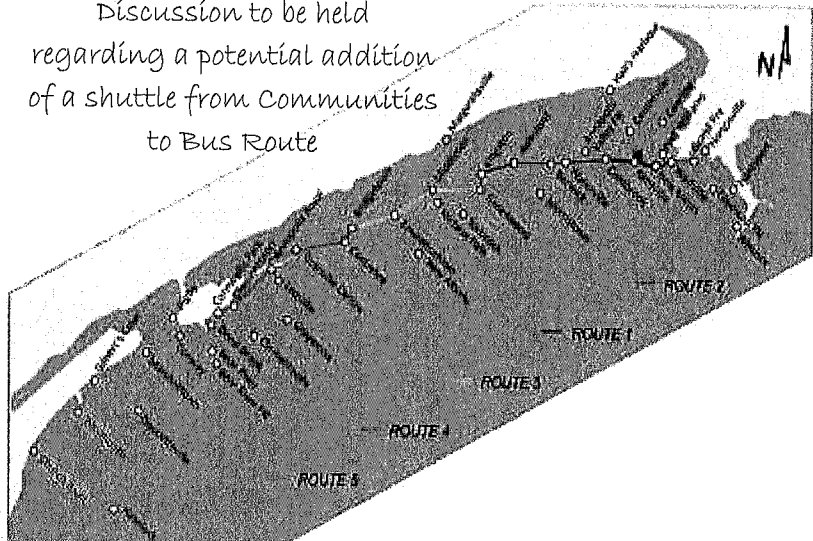


KINGS TRANSIT AUTHORITY TRANSIT MASTER PLAN
