### What is MAEP?

The Mi'kmaq Artist Emergence Program (MAEP) was created to help talented, creative Mi'kmaq youth through music creation, production and healing.

### The goals of MAEP are:

- to support Mi'kmaq artists through mentorship, training, and wholistic development
- Prioritize artist wellness by integrating mental health and cultural supports alongside professional development
- Provide mentorship, training, and writing and recording opportunities for emerging Mi'kmaq artists
- Strengthen cultural identity and artistic confidence through Mi'kmaq language, storytelling, and traditional knowledge
- Create access points to the Nova Scotia, Atlantic Canadian and national music industry
- Support long-term sustainability of Mi'kmaq artists within the creative economy
