WHAT ARE THE 94 CALLS TO ACTION?

The Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada (TRC) released 94 Calls to Action in 2015. They are a roadmap for repairing the harms of residential schools and for building respectful, equitable and lasting relationships between Indigenous and non-Indigenous peoples in Canada.

The Calls to Action call on governments, institutions, businesses and all Canadians to take concrete steps toward truth, justice, healing and reconciliation.

IT'S ABOUT PEOPLE

The Calls to Action are about the Survivors, their families, and the next seven generations. They are about dignity, respect, and creating a Canada where Indigenous and non-Indigenous peoples walk forward together in a good way.
